Featured Crystal: Larimar



Larimar is a rare blue variety of the silicate mineral called pectolite. Colors of this gemstone vary from white, light blue, green-blue or deep blue. It's unique blue coloration is the result of the addition of copper instead of calcium. This gemstone is formed when volcanoes erupted, filling cavities with minerals, including the blue pectolite. When the rocks around them erode, the deposits are carried down the slope and to the sea, where they are naturally polished against the seabed.

Because of the unique way these gemstones are created they are considered rare and can only be found in one location in the world, the Dominican Republic in the Caribbean. Originally discovered in 1916 by Father Miguel Domingo Fuertes, his request to mine the stone was rejected. It wasn't rediscovered until 1974 by Miguel Mendez and Peace Corps volunteer Norman Rilling. The gemstone was named after Miguel Mendez's daughter Larissa, combined with the Spanish word for the sea "mar."

Before the official discovery, local inhabitants of the region had long been aware of the stone nicknamed the blue stone. Island legends believed the stone was produced by the sea because it could easily be collected on the beach. Another legend associated with the gemstone involves the American psychic, Edgar Cayce. Cayce predicted that some of the missing parts from the lost city of Atlantis would be found in an island of the Caribbean. The prophecies went on to mention a blue stone with extraordinary virtues. Cayce's followers believe Larimar to be this blue gemstone of the prophecy. Today it is more commonly referred to as the Caribbean Gem.

The largest outcropping of Larimar is located in Los Chupaderos, about 6.2 miles southwest of the city of Barahona in the southwestern region of the Dominican Republic. It is considered a local specialty in the Caribbean, and is often found set in silver and occasionally gold. The more intense the blue color, the rarer and higher the quality. This is one gemstone that you do not want to leave out in the sun as it is photosensitive and the beautiful blue color will fade if exposed to too much sunlight and/or heat.

According to "Love Is In The Earth," by Melody, Larimar has the following healing properties:

"Larimar can assist one in recognizing the "chains" which have been self-imposed, stimulating one to release the self-constraints in order to facilitate freedom from bondage of the materialistic world.

It further helps one to admit to guilt, when guilty, and emits a love for the user that brings a sense of peace in truthfulness. It has also been used for dimensional work and for cellular work. It is an excellent mineral for purging entities from one's environment and from one's corporeal existence.

Larimar has been used to bring customers to the salesperson, generally a variety quite different than the usual. It is also quite helpful in discouraging pugnacity and overzealous displays of one's character.

Larimar has been used to treat the cartilaginous portions of the body, as well as the hair and the feet. In relation to the feet, it can open the acupressure/acupuncture meridians at the feet in order to allow one to recognize which painful spots lead to which areas of the body; this information provides the user with the knowledge of the dis-eases which can be directly affected through healing encounters.

It assists in precision and forthright-ness in activities, and stimulates the deeper understanding of being in this world.

In addition, Larimar is a "stone for Earth healing." It represents peace and clarity, emitting an energy of healing and love. It has been used to stimulate the heart, throat, third-eye, and crown chakras, facilitating inner wisdom and outer manifestation. It helps one to "see" the self from outside of the realm of personal reality, inspiring and encouraging one toward improvement in the actualization of one's realities on both the spiritual and physical planes. It has also been used for gridding, bringing serenity to an environment and providing a message of loving energy to those of other worlds. It also additionally resonates to the Astrological Sign of Cancer.
